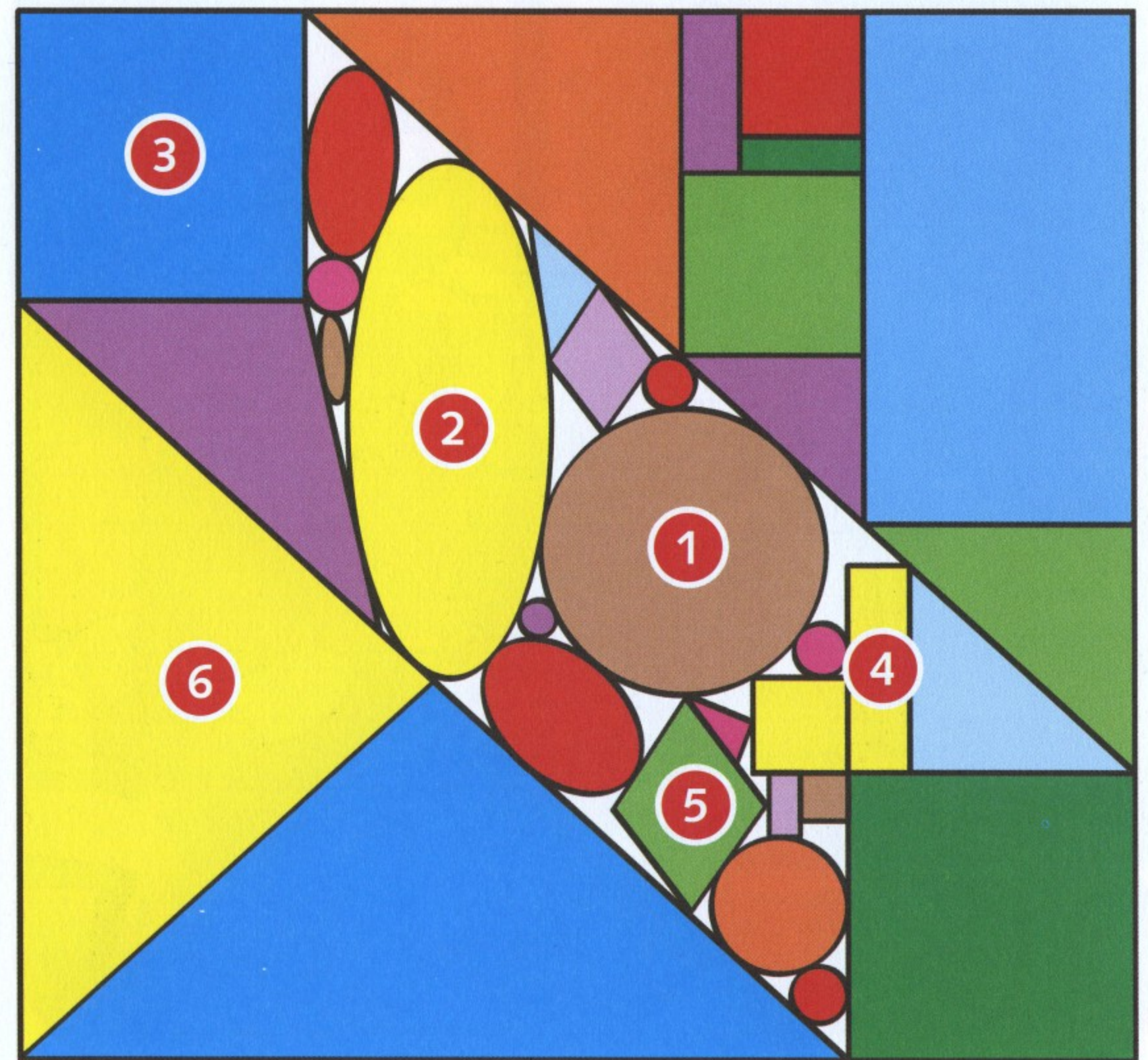

Every Tuesday morning Mary has art class at her school. Mary isn't happy. She hates art.



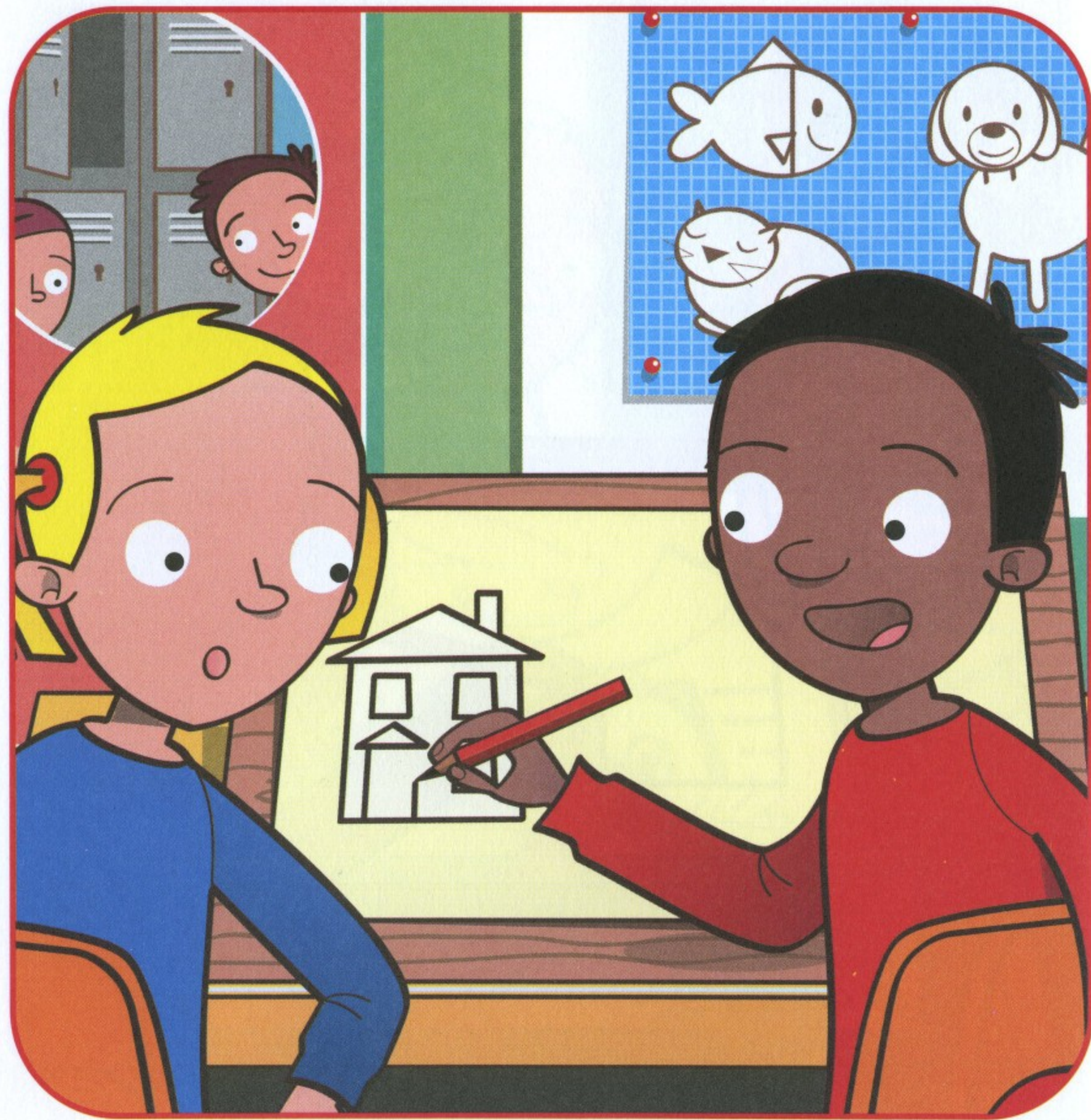
Mary is sitting at her desk. She can't draw very well. "It's too hard," she says.

“You can use ovals and triangles.”

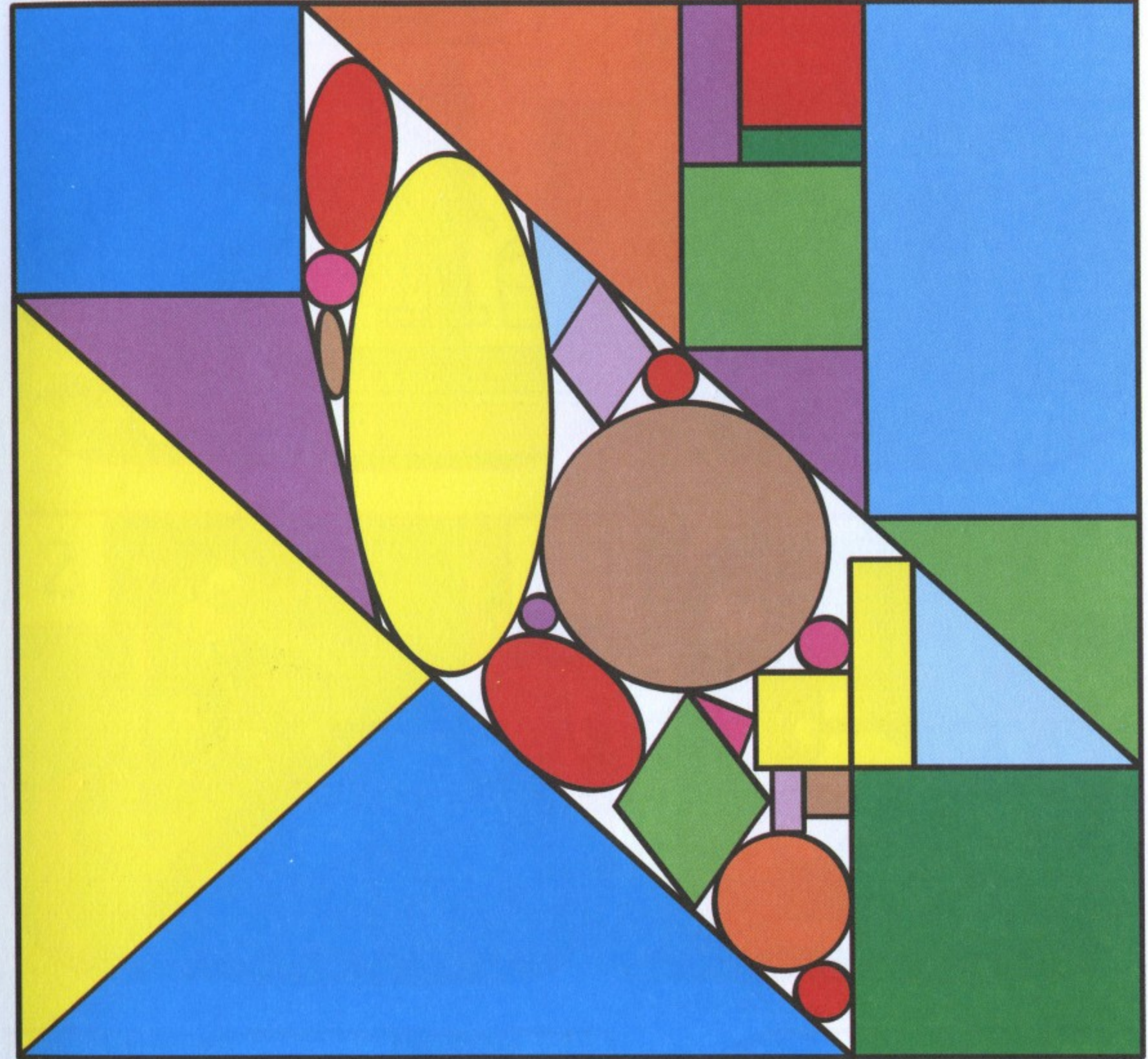
