Look through the weather forecast and pay attention to the highlighted phrases. Then look at the pictures and find the correct weather forecast.

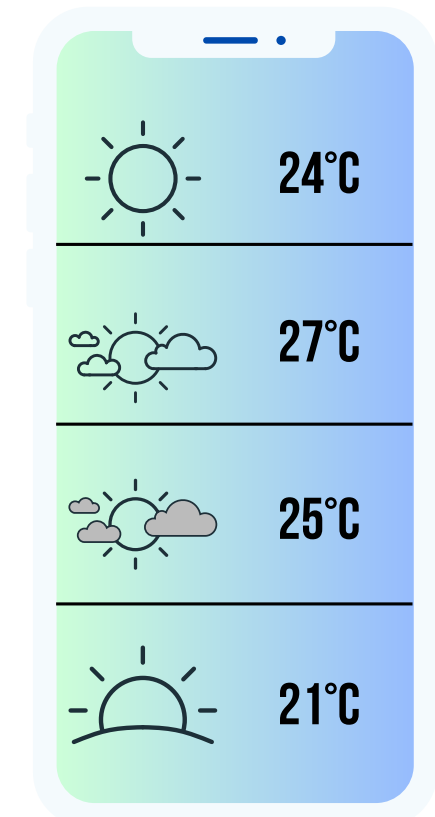
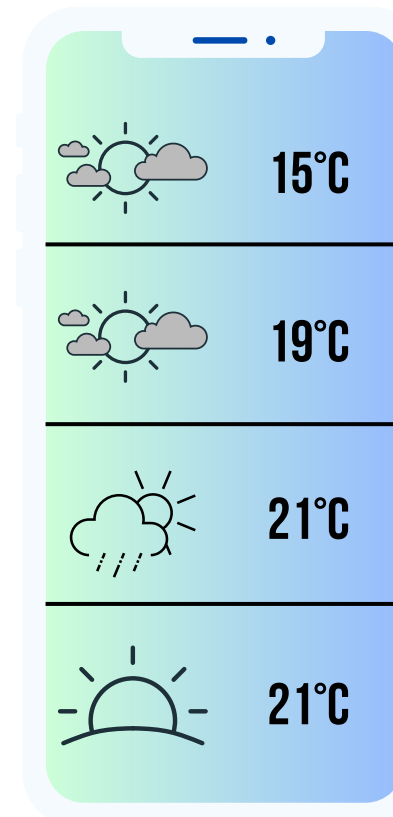
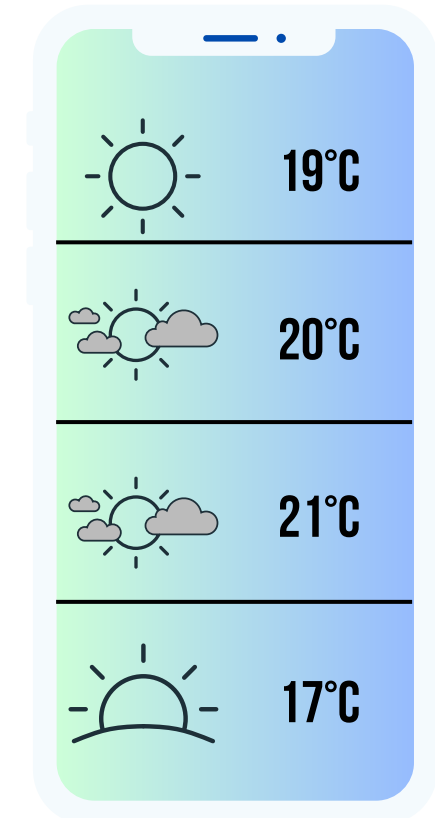
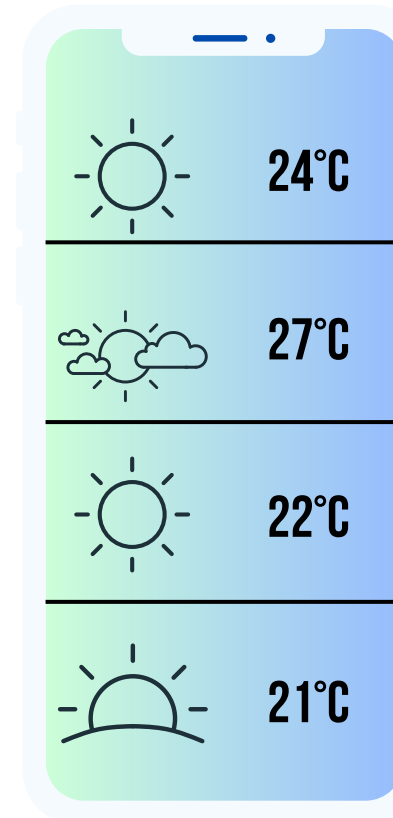
It's time for your weather forecast for today, August 2, 2023.

In the morning: The sun is shining brightly, so **it's going to be** a sunny day! **Don't forget** your hat and sunglasses if you go outside to play.

During the day: **It's going to be** warm and pleasant with temperatures around 27°C (degrees Celsius). It **will be** a bit humid, so don't forget to drink plenty of water.

In the afternoon: Some clouds **will** appear in the sky, but don't worry, it **won't be** rainy today. **It's going to be** a great time to enjoy outdoor activities.

In the evening: As the sun sets, the temperature **will** start to cool down a bit. It **will be** around 21°C (Degrees Celsius) in the evening, so if you're going out, bring a light jacket or sweater.

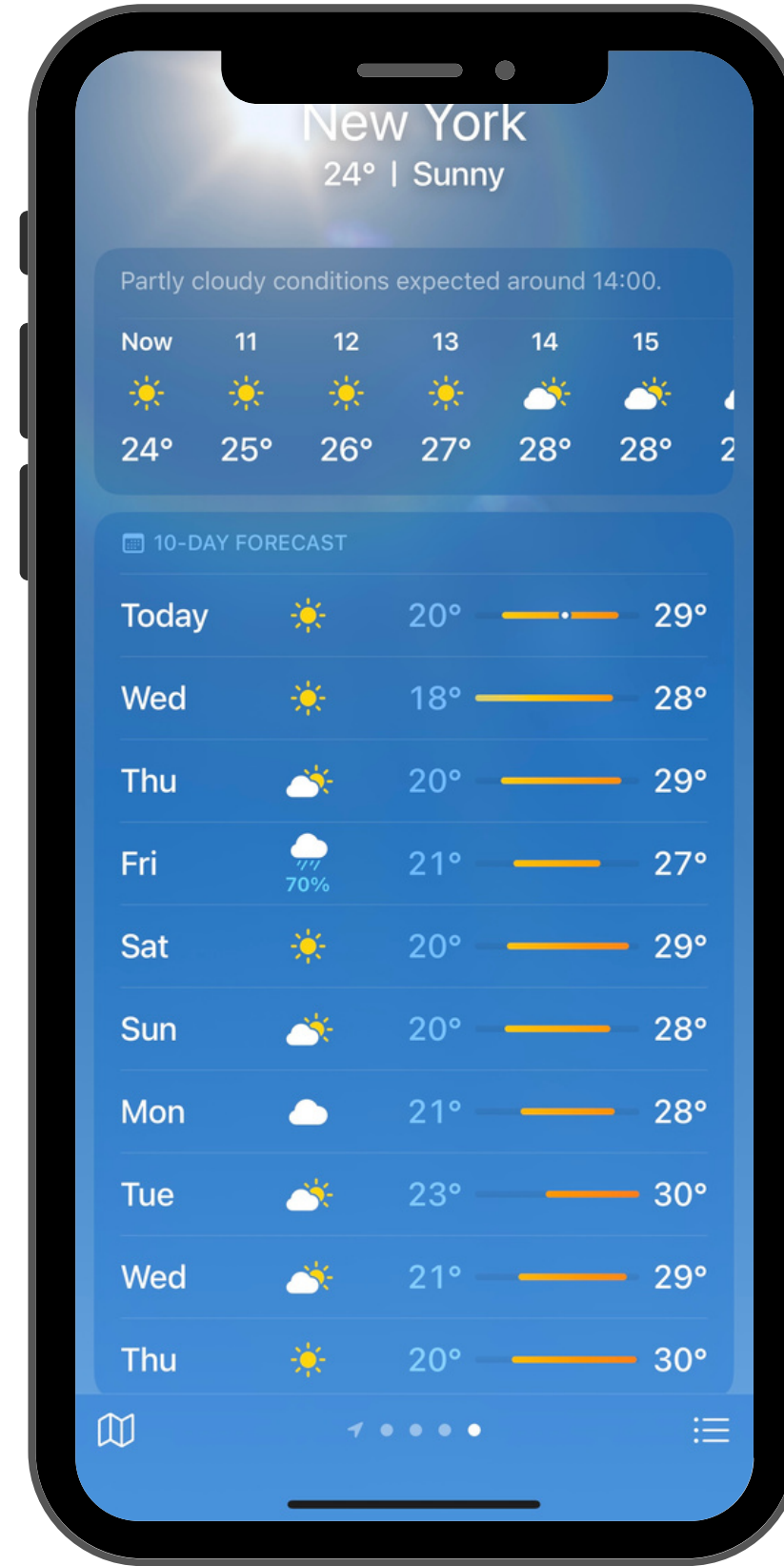

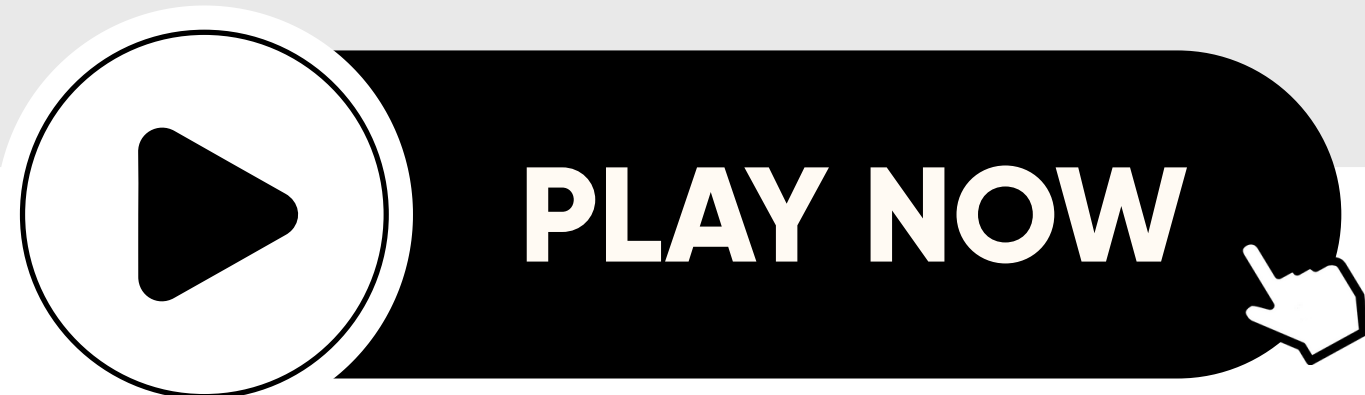
