Mixed conditionals are sentences that <u>combine the second and third conditional together.</u>

Mixed conditionals help us talk about actions through different times.

Functions

past action with present result

present condition with past result

future action with past result

Examples

If I hadn't fought with my girlfriend, I wouldn't be sitting alone today.

If she were more sociable, she would have found a date for Valentine's Day.

If he weren't participating in a match tomorrow, he would have stayed at the party longer.






